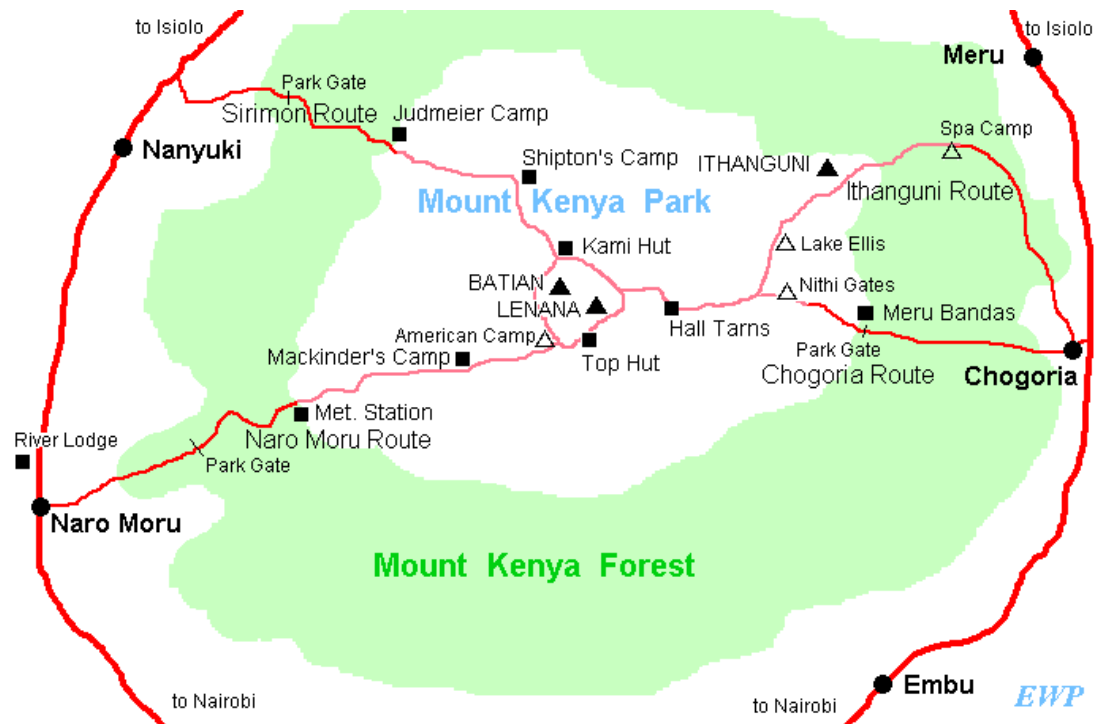


CLIMBING HOLIDAYS

MOUNT KENYA CLIMB



NARO MORU ROUTE

SF27

Day 1

Depart from Nairobi for Naro Moru town arriving in time for lunch at Naro Moru River Lodge. You will meet your guide who will help you to prepare your equipment ready to start your climb and to answer your questions before hand. Rest of the day spent acclimatizing.

Day 2

After breakfast drive to the main gate where your driver/guide will drop you off to commence your climb to the mountain, ascending 10 km through the rain forest to the Met station where you will stop. Dinner and overnight stay at the Met station.

Day 3 Mackinders

After breakfast continue ascent to Mackinders Camp. Dinner and overnight stay at Mackinders Camp.

Day 4 Met Station

Very early morning start (02:30 hrs) and attempt to climb to point Lenana at 17,058 ft. Thereafter commence your descent to Mackinders Camp for a hearty breakfast and continue down to the Met Station for dinner and overnight stay.

Day 5 Nairobi

After breakfast descend to the last section of the mountain where your driver/guide will be on hand to meet you and transfer you to Naro Moru River Lodge to pick up your luggage before departing for Nairobi and drop off at your hotel.

SIRIMON ROUTE – 5 DAYS

Day 1 – Nairobi – Nanyuki

Pick up from your hotel and drive to Nanyuki arriving in time for lunch at the sportsman's arms hotel. Here you will meet your guide who will be willing to answer all your questions and explain to you what you need to do in preparation for your climb and also explain to you about the weather on the mountain. The rest of the day is spent acclimatising.

Day 2 – Old Moses Hut

Transfer from the Sportsman's Arms Hotel to Sirimon Gate where your climb will commence. Walk through the rain forest for 9 km (5 hour walk) to the first mountain hut – Old Moses' Hut.

Day 3 – Shipton Hut

After breakfast continue the climb through Mackinders Valley to the second hut – Shipton Hut at 4200m. Dinner and overnight stay at Shipton Hut.

Day 4 – Old Moses Hut

Early morning climb to Point Lenana at 4,985m. On a clear day you should be able to see Mount Kilimanjaro to the South, Mount Elgon to the West and the Indian Ocean to the East. Thereafter begin your descent to Shipton Hut for a hearty breakfast, thereafter descending to Old Moses' Hut for dinner and overnight stay.

Day 5 – Nairobi

After breakfast descend to the gate where your driver/guide will be waiting to take you back to Nairobi where the tour ends.

CHOGORIA ROUTE – 5 DAYS

Day 1 Nairobi – Nanyuki

Pick up from your hotel and drive to Nanyuki arriving at Ibis Hotel for lunch. Rest of the day is spent with your guide preparing your climbing equipment. Our mountain guides are very friendly and willing to answer all the questions that you might want to know before you start. Dinner and overnight stay at the Ibis Hotel.

Day 2 – Old Moses Hut

After breakfast you will be transferred to the Sirimon Gate where your climb will commence. Walk to the first mountain hut – The Old Moses for dinner and overnight stay.

Day 3 – Shipton Camp

After breakfast walk via Mackinders Valley to Shipton Camp for dinner and overnight stay.

Day 4 – Road Head Camp

Wake up at 02:30 hrs and climb to point Lenana. Thereafter begin your descent to Mintos – at 4,360m for a hearty breakfast. Continue to Road Head for dinner and overnight stay.

Day 5 – Nairobi

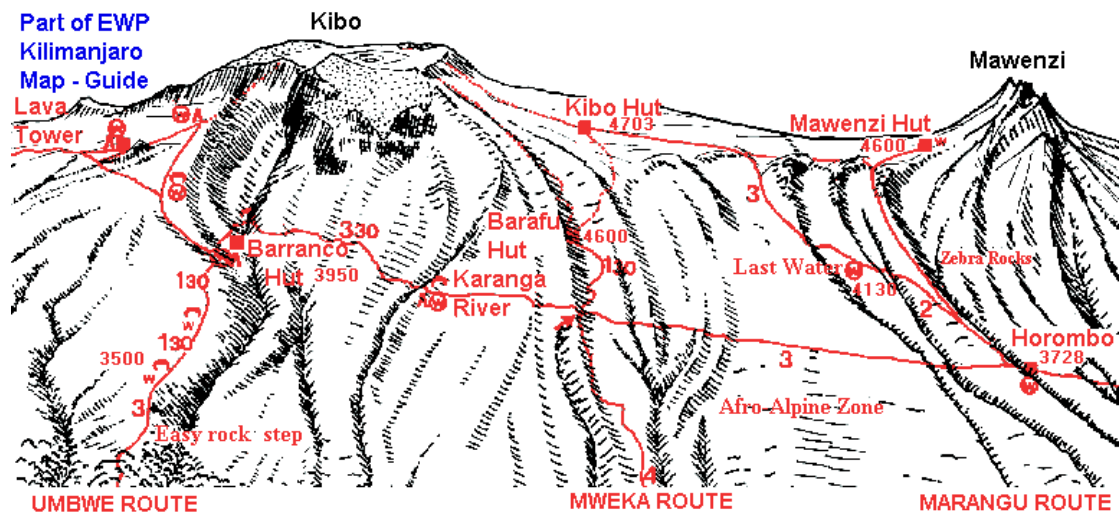
After breakfast an early walk will take you to Chogoria for lunch where you will meet your driver/guide for your departure to Nairobi and drop off at your hotel.

KILIMANJARO CLIMB

MARANGU ROUTE – 7 DAYS

Day 1 Nairobi – Moshi

Pick up and transfer to Namanga border arriving latest 10:00 hrs, continue and arrive at Arusha for lunch. Continue to Moshi where the rest of the day will be spent preparing for the climb.

Day 2 Moshi – Mandara Hut

After breakfast drive 45 kms to Marangu gate at an altitude of 1,860m. Walk 9 kms through dense semi-tropical rain forest to Mandara hut at 2,744m. All meals and overnight stay at Mandara Hut.

Day 3 Mandara – Horombo Hut

Early morning start with 10 hour walk toward Horombo. The landscape becomes rockier with both Mawenzi and Kibo peaks in full view. Dinner and overnight stay at Horombo Hut.

Day 4 **Horombo – Kibo Hut**

Continue your ascent to Kibo Hut, which will take 6 hours. Kibo hut stands at 4,732m above sea level. Spectacular mountain vegetation such as giant cacti, groundswell and lobelia grace the scenery. All meals and overnight stay at Kibo Hut.

Day 5 **Kibo Hut – Horombo Hut**

The final attempt to the summit is made in the early hours of the morning at 02:00 hrs. It takes about 5 hours to climb the steepest and most difficult part of the route to Gilman's Point at 5,681 m in time to watch the spectacular sunrise. After signing the visitor's book continue to Uhuru Peak at 5,896m, thereafter returning to Horombo Hut for dinner and overnight stay.

Day 6 **Horombo – Moshi**

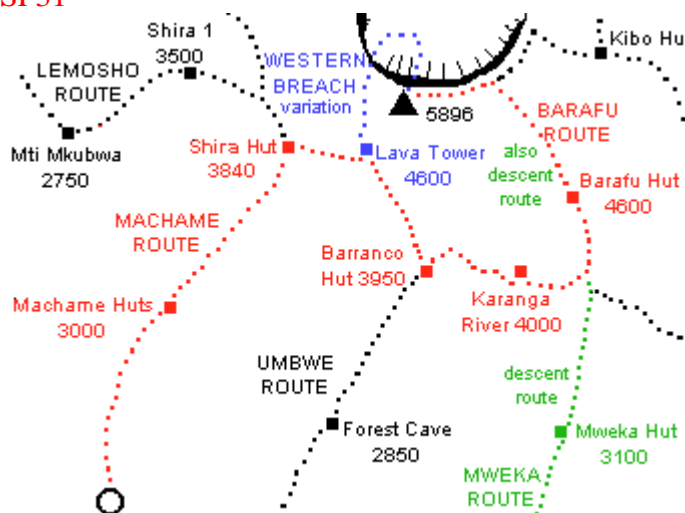
After breakfast walk down to Marangu for your transfer, dinner and overnight in Moshi.

Day 7 **Moshi – Nairobi**

After breakfast to Arusha for lunch. Thereafter transfer to Namanga border where our driver/guide will be on hand to receive you and transport you back to your hotel in Nairobi.

MACHAME ROUTE – 7 DAYS

Day 1 **Nairobi – Machame**

Pick up from your Nairobi hotel to drive to Namanga border. After immigration formalities, drive to Machame Gate and walk through the forest to Machame Hut at 300m. Dinner and overnight stay at Machame Hut.

Day 2 **Machame – Shira Hut**

After breakfast, cross the valley and continue along the steep ridge going on to rock ridges and through heather. The route turns west into a river gorge leading to Shira Hut at 3,800m. Dinner and overnight stay at Shira Hut.

Day 3 Shira Hut – Baranco Hut

After breakfast continue towards Kibo, passing the junction then East towards the Lava Tower. You will then climb down to Baranco Hut at 3,940m shortly thereafter.

Day 4 Barrafu Hut

From Baranco a steep rocky climb up the Baranco and walls on through to Karanga Valley with a final stop at Barrafu Hut.

Day 5 Barrafu Hut – Mweka Hut

An early start for the summit, first to Stella Point and unto Uhuru Peak at 5,895m then begin your descend via the Mweka. Dinner and overnight at Mweka Hut.

Day 6 Mweka Hut – Arusha

Continue down to Mweka route and meet up with your driver/guide for the drive to Arusha where you will enjoy a steaming hot shower before dinner. Overnight at the hotel in Arusha.

Day 7 Arusha – Nairobi

After a well earned rest and a hearty breakfast depart for Namanga border and continue to Nairobi for your drop off at the hotel.

Reservations

Alterations to tours
